## Student Right-to-Know Act Graduation Rate Report Williams Baptist University

In accordance with the Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act of 1990, Williams Baptist University is sharing the following information on the graduation rates of our <u>Fall 2015</u> cohort of full-time, first-time degree seeking undergraduates.

As reported in the IPEDS graduation rates survey (GRS), during the Fall 2015 semester, 126 first-time, full-time degree-seeking undergraduate students enrolled at Williams Baptist University. Of these students, 32% had graduated from WBU within 150% of the normal time to complete their degree (as of August 31, 2021).

While reviewing this information, please keep the following in mind:

- All graduation rates are based on up to six years of attendance for bachelor's programs, which equates to 150% of the normal completion time.
- We have elected to not report transfer-out rates because our University's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in another eligible institution without completing or graduating.
- These charts do not identify why our students withdrew; therefor, students who withdrew for personal or medical reasons are included.
- Graduation rates do not include students who left school to serve in the U.S. Armed Forces, on official church missions, or with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were totally and permanently disabled.
